About Project Smile

a 501c(3) non profit organization

serving traumatized children in New England

Project Smile is a non profit organization dedicated to easing the pain and fear of children involved in traumatic situations. We donate stuffed animals, reading books, coloring books and crayons to police and fire departments for individual officers, fire fighters and paramedics to give to children. Since our founding in October 2003, we have donated over 30,000 stuffed animals and work with 164 police and fire departments both locally and throughout New England.

Project Smile also partners with homeless shelters and the Department of Children and Families and donates stuffed animals, coloring books/crayons and reading books for children entering foster care and/or living in homeless shelters. Many of the 9,000 children who enter foster care annually in Massachusetts have few, if any, personal possessions with them.

Many of the children who receive items from Project Smile are:

- Involved in car accidents
- Victims of abuse or other violent crimes
- Sick or injured
- Entering foster care or living in homeless shelters
- Witnesses of domestic violence and crime
- Victims of house fires
- Coping with loss of a loved one

Your sponsorship directly supports Project Smile's efforts by:

- Helping more children through reaching additional police and fire departments and replenishing the supply of stuffed animals to the departments already participating.
- Donating stuffed animals, books and coloring books/crayons to the Department of Children and Families for children entering foster care.
